ABOUT JAIL & BAIL

This hugely entertaining courtroom drama event will see you arrested, charged with your crime (entirely fictitious, of course) and then placed on trial.

As our jailbird, you will be found guilty of your 'wicked and entirely fictional crime'. You will be taken into custody, photographed and banished to the cells at Live Escape Salisbury.

Your freedom will only be guaranteed if the suggested minimum bail requirement of £999 is raised! To help you raise the bail, make sure to use all your connections, including friends, family, and colleagues.


